"Thank you so much for praying for our small community of Japanese women: Mika, Kei, Saori, and me. We just had our final Bible study yesterday, followed by a farewell time (for Kei and Saori since they're returning to Japan the week after next) and birthday luncheon for



Mika. Since this is my last chance to teach them the Bible in this group, I wanted to show them how to listen to God and I wanted to hire a Japanese babysitter for their children whom they bring to the study. But the sitter had told me that she would not be available today. Then my Navigator colleague and friend Karen Taniguchi, who is passing through DC on her way to Boston this week, offered to watch the kids. What an excellent sitter God provided for this occasion!

So, I was able to teach the women some principles of listening prayer, and then we took turns listening to God, asking Him how He views each individual sitting around the table: Mika, Kei, and Saori. God showed up in a very tangible way, giving us consistent messages for each person by bringing to our minds Bible verses or by giving us images. God beckoned Saori who has been hesitant to commit herself fully to Him, He delighted in Kei's contentment in Him, and He affirmed His joy over Mika."

"This photo marks something very significant. One of the greatest anxieties I battled coming to Thailand was that I would be apart from Sophie every morning, five days a week, for our first year here. It's not what I wanted. But what I WANT is often not best. Sophie loves her friends, trusts the precious women who care for her well and surprises us with



how much she is learning. And I have a unique opportunity to really dive into the Thai language in a focused way that many don't. God is good and trustworthy. I'll be thrilled to be with her all day again when language school ends this summer but, for now, I'll thank God for what He's done for us."

Prayer Request: Language, language, language!

The Thai language has 44 consonant symbols, 28 vowel symbols, and 5 tones. That is one reason why the first year in Thailand will be spent on language study. This is because they believe that the best way to reach a people with the gospel is to enter into their world. Paul said, "To the Jews I became as a Jew, in order to win the Jews. To those under the law I became as one under the law...that I might win those under the law" (1 Cor. 9:20).
